- 1. Call to order: President Randy Garrison called the meeting to order at 1830.

It was determined that we need a new Certificate of Deposit for the Building Fund and to add to our existing CD for the vehicle fund. Greg motioned to move \$20,000.00 from checking and \$40,000.00 from our Money Market into a new Certificate of Deposit at one of our three banks with the best interest rate from one of our local banks for the Vehicle Fund

For the Building Fund move \$130,000/00 from the Money Market to a new CD with the best interest rate and \$180,000.00 from the Checking to CD 4757 at BlackHawk Bank and Trust. Bruce seconded. Motion approved 4 Ayes and 0 Nays.

 Transformer Fire and 1 Fire Alarm.
 - Mutual was given to Cordova Fire Department for 1 Shed Fire.

Chief Carey asked the board for permission to get 10 more P25 radios Rock Island Fire Department which are free. The district will be responsible for the maintenance cost and reprograming. No motion needed.
